Statement of Faith:

1. The Bible

- a. The Bible is the inspired Word of God. It gives a true history of the creation of heaven, earth, and humanity.
- b. The Bible contains correct prophecy of the ages to come regarding heaven, earth, and the destiny of humanity.
- c. The Bible is True and Authoritative and it teaches us how to be saved and lead a Godly life.

2. Plan of Salvation:

- a. Through Sin, Humans have separated themselves from God. Though we like to think ourselves as basically good, we're deceiving ourselves if we claimed we haven't sinned (Romans 3:23, 1 John: 8-10)
- b. Only through the blood of Christ we receive deliverance from all sin and unrighteousness.
- c. We believe only through a PERSONAL relationship with Jesus Christ is the only way back to God (John 14:6).
- d. To be forgiven, we must admit we are going the wrong way and ask God to forgive us of our sins, and see the need for him in our lives.
- e. We must be baptized in the name of Lord Jesus Christ for the remission of sins. This is a necessary part of New Testament Salvation as the apostles and other followers did (Acts 2:36-41; 8:16; and 19:5).
- f. We must receive spiritual baptism available for all believers today, and the Bible describes it as a spiritual birth. The prophet Joel (Acts 2:16-18) and Apostle Peter (Acts 2:39). The evidence of receiving the Holy Ghost is speaking in other tongues (other languages) as the Spirit of God gives utterance (Acts 2:4).

3. Divine Healing

- a. The Apostles prayed for the sick as prophesized by Jesus in Mark 16:18: "They shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover." We are promised divine healing in James 5:14-15: "Is any sick among you? Let him call for the elders of the church; and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord shall raise him up."

Lost and Found

“Either what woman having ten pieces of silver, if she lose one piece, doth not light a candle, and sweep the house, and seek diligently till she find it?” (Luke 15:8)

In 2 Kings 22:8-13, 18-20 the high priest Hilkiah found the lost scrolls of the Law in the house of the Lord. This scroll was once revered and used in worship but, over time, was devalued and not used any more in worship. Hence the scroll got misplaced and lost for generations.

This is what happens to us today. We look for the treasures (or idols) of the world (pursuit of money, fame, fortune, entertainment, etc.). We spend the greater parts of our lives trying to find our “buried treasure.” But forget there is no greater treasure than the “Word of God.” In the Bible are a multitude of buried treasures that only require extraction – someone willing to take the time to “dig them out.”

“When the King first found out about the discovery of the lost scrolls he “rent his clothes.” God’s Word causes in a sincere believer “repentance.” When a person believes the Bible is “God’s Word” and he or she sincerely desires to please God, then (s)he desires to obey the Word.

“The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom: and the knowledge of the holy is understanding.” (Proverbs 9:10). Within this context: “Fear of the Lord” refers to awe, reverence, honor, and respect. When the Word shines the light of truth upon his errant ways, it produces condemnation and contrition within the heart of the believer, which initiates repentance. Such was the case of King Josiah when he heard the reading of the lost “Book of the Law.”

Faith in the Law caused the king to spring into immediate action:

1. He repented personally (2 Kings 22:11-20).
2. He gathered the people together and had the Word read in their hearing (2 Kings 23:1-2).
3. He covenanted with the Lord to obey the Word (2 Kings 23:3).
4. He cleared out and destroyed all other elements of idol worship, perversion, and defilement (2 Kings 23:5-19).
5. He cleared out and destroyed all other elements of idol worship, perversion, and defilement. He had the idolatrous priests slain. (2 Kings 23:5-19 and 2 Kings 23:20 respectively).
6. He reinstated the Passover (2 Kings 23:21-23).
7. He began to perform all the words of the Law and serve God with all his heart so that he was unlike any king before or after him (2 Kings 23:24-25).

These are vital lessons for believers today! Our only hope of revival and redemption come through God’s Word. May we always treasure this!
